Public Question Time

The Chairman brought forward agenda item 10 (Secn 106 Public Open Space money) and with members permission suspended Standing Orders to enable members of the public to engage in the debate

Two main points arose from the debate

- The need for play equipment for children in the village
- The problem with car parking for functions associated with the Village hall.

Discussions followed on the possible solutions to these issues and some points made were that it might be possible to sell the existing Village Hall for development and use that money and possible other grants from the Fullabrook project to relocate to a site adjacent to the school. An alternative proposal was to attempt to obtain land to the rear of the Village Hall to provide car parking. It was **RESOLVED**

- That the Chairman pursue the possibility of obtaining land either to the rear of the existing village hall or adjacent to the school (both in the same ownership).
- A further meeting to be held following these discussions
